- What trees can you see in your garden or when you're out for a walk?

Horse chestnut: These produce chestnuts, or conkers, and were brought to the UK from Turkey in the late 16th century.



Holly: Holly plants are either male or female - females produce berries, males do not. These berries are toxic to humans, so don't eat them!



Oak: Oak trees have been around longer than humans and can live to be 1000 years old. They can produce up to 10 million acorns in their life!



Pine: There are around 120 types of pine (trees and shrubs!). The Scots pine is our national tree, native to the ancient Caledonian forests.
